In accordance with the by-laws of the Montford Point Marine Association, Finney Greggs is enthusiastically recommended for inclusion into the Association Hall-of Fame. Finney Greggs has served as the Director, Montford Point Marine Museum aboard Camp Johnson for over 15 years. During his tenure the Museum has grown from a haphazard room of memorabilia to a vital museum showcasing the rich history of the Montford

Point Marines. With a limited budget, Finney secured resources from the Camp Commander and other donors to established well documented museum with displays, pictures, artifacts and oral histories of the first black Marines. Finney coordinated with the past base Commander of Camp Johnson to include the museum on the check in list of each arriving Marine and sailor to the base. This ensures that a new generation of service members learns of the rich Marine history of these first black Marines.

Finney also served as the technical advisor to the first, full length documentary film which feature Academy Award winning actor, Louis Gossett Jr. as the narrator. Finney provided vital technical and logistical assistance to ensure this film project was completed. The development of the Montford Point Marine documentary by the University of North Carolina was made easier thanks to the support of Mr. Greggs. His service as the Montford Point Marine Museum curators expands almost the total existence of the museum itself. Thanks to his commitment to this task colleges and universities seek his support for their programs on a regular basis.
